7	For an ordinance amending Section 18-81, D.R.M.C. setting the salaries of elected				
8 9	officers for terms beginning July 20, 2015				
10	WHEREAS, the Colorado Constitution and Charter of the City and County of Denver				
11	prohibit the salaries of elected officials from being increased or decreased during a term of				
12	office; and				
13					
14	WHEREAS, section 9.2.2 of the charter requires the City Council to establish the				
15	salaries for the ensuing term of elected Charter officers after January 1 of each year in which a				
16	general city election will be held, but before the general election; and				
17					
18	WHEREAS, any increase in the salaries of elected officials is limited to the cumulative				
19	increase in the Denver-Boulder-Greeley CPI or the cumulative increase in the mean salary of				
20	employees in the Career Service, whichever is less; and				
21					
22	WHEREAS, the cumulative increase in the Denver-Boulder-Greeley CPI during the				
23	period 2011 through 2014, inclusive, was [%]; and

25	WHEREAS, as reported by the Office of Human Resources, the cumulative increase in				
26	the mean salary of employees in the Career Service for the period 2011 through 2014,				
27	inclusive, was 10.3%, meaning that the annual salaries of Denver elected officials cannot				
28	increase in excess of 10.3% during the next four year term of the elected officials commencing				
29	July 20, 2015.

34	Section 1. Section 18-81, D.R.M.C., concerning the salaries of elected charter officers	is			

hereby amended by deleting the language stricken and adding the language underlined to read as follows:

Sec. 18-81. Salaries.

In accordance with the limitations on the salaries of elected charter officers as set forth in section 9.2.2 of the charter, the council hereby fixes the annual salaries for the term beginning July 18, 2011 July 20, 2015 as follows:
