The process to rename Barnum North Park was initiated by the family of Sam Sandos. The petition was submitted and championed by Councilman Paul López' Office. The petition included 700 complete signatures (200 more than required) and five letters of support, including letters from Councilman Paul López; Councilwoman At Large Deborah Ortega; Concerned Citizens for Barnum President Kaye Boeke; Villa Park Neighborhood Association member Jo Ann Phillips; and former Mayor Federico Pena. Sam Sandos was a life-long resident of the Villa Park neighborhood and served as the council representative for District 3 from 1975 to 1987. He started various programs and projects such as Denver Health Westside Clinic, the Sam Sandos Christmas Basket program, and the Hispanic Annual Salute.
