

CITY CONTRACT FOR JANITORIAL SERVICES WITH LAKEVIEW RENOVATIONS, INC.

(DBA NORTH AMERICAN PROPERTY SERVICES AKA NAPS)

Contract Amendment History

- Contract commenced January 1st, 2010.
 - Provides custodial services to 19 facilities for the City and County of Denver.
 - Total dollar amount of original contract: \$7,145,304
- 1st Amendment: February 2010, replaces surety performance bond requirement with a letter of credit.
- **2**nd **Amendment**: November 2012, contract term clarified to not exceed December 31, 2014. Adds provision prohibiting employment of undocumented persons.
- **3rd Amendment:** May 2013, City agrees to reimburse NAPS for prevailing wage increases beginning January 1, 2013. Contract maximum increased to \$12,145,304.
- **Proposed 4th amendment:** Increase contract maximum by \$350,000 to \$12,495,304.
