**A BILL**

**For an ordinance establishing a new Fund in the Public Health Special Revenue Fund Series for the “Community Health Promotion Donations” program.**

**WHEREAS**, the Denver Department of Public Health and Environment has a need for a fund that can receive donations to its community health programs;




**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

**Section 1.** A new fund is hereby established in the Public Health Special Revenue Fund Series, Accounting No. 14000, a “Community Health Promotion Donations” Fund, Accounting No. 14704, for the purpose of accounting for the receipt and expenditure of program dollars.

**Section 2.** Monies received from donations from private entities for Accounting No. 14704 shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Revenue Fund No. 14000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

**Section 3.** Program expenditures are hereby authorized for the “Community Health Promotion Donations” Fund, Accounting No. 14704, in the amount not to exceed deposits as described in Section 2 of this ordinance to be expended by the Executive Director of the Denver Department of Public Health and Environment. Allowable expenses include expenditures associated with the Denver Department of Public Health and Environment’s community health programs. This Fund is revenue-based and non-lapsing.

**Section 4.** The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
