The City owns approximately 11.7 acres located at Girard Avenue and Havana Street. DPS owns a building located at 1330 Fox Street. The City and DPS desire to enter into a Contract to Exchange Property so that they may trade properties, provide for a cash payment from the City to DPS to perform the maintenance of Fox Street and perform certain other activities as set forth in the Agreement. Cash payment to be paid by a non-profit entity that intends to run a Domestic Violence Center at 1330 Fox Street.
