10	WHEREAS, in the Denver General Election in November 2024, Denver voters approved				
11	Referred Measure 2Q to increase the sales and use tax by a rate of 0.34 percent; and				
12	WHEREAS, per the approved Measure 2Q the Denver Health and Hospital Authority will				
13	receive said revenue to fund certain services as defined in Ordinance 0717, series of 2024; and				
14	WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver wishes to create a new Special Revenue Fund				
15	to receive revenue and administer services;				
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17	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY				
18	OF DENVER:				
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20	Section 1. A new fund is hereby established in the General Government Special Revenue Fund				
21	Accounting No. 11000, a "Denver Health and Hospital Authority Tax Fund", Accounting No. 11892,				
22	for the purpose of receiving and accounting for the Denver Health and Hospital Authority's revenue				
23	from the increase in sales and use tax.				
24	Section 2. Monies received from 2Q tax revenue, as well as any interest earned on said				
25	monies, shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Revenue Fund No.				
26	11000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City				
27	and County of Denver.				
28	Section 3. Program expenditures are hereby authorized for the "Denver Health and Hospita				
29	Authority Tax Fund", Accounting No. 11892, to be expended by the Manager of Public Health and				
30	Environment. Authorized expenditures for Accounting No. 11892 include those stipulated in article				
31	XV of Chapter 24 of the Denver Revised Municipal Code, as amended by Referred Measure 2Q and				
32	any subsequent amendments. This is an appropriated, lapsing fund.				
33	Section 4. To ensure that the correct amount of revenue is appropriated to this voter-approved				
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program, the amount appropriated each year shall be increased or decreased administratively by
the difference between (1) the prior year's appropriation that was based upon estimated revenues
and (2) the actual revenues received in the prior year as determined by the annual audit of the
City's financial statements, per fiscal year-end close.

5	Section 6. The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized
6	and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be
7	necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
