Through the efforts of a community-led committee, a full packet was presented to the PRAB which included: 305 signatures in support (300 are required). The Denver Parks and Recreation Advisory Board held a public hearing on the January 10, 2024 meeting, where PRAB approved the motion unanimously. The unnamed park at Iliff and Bellaire, is bounded by S. Birch St. to the east, S. Bellaire St. to the west, E. Iliff Ave. to the south, and E. Warren Ave. to the north.
