Denver International Airport (DEN) was selected into the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) for the guardrail upgrades on Peña Boulevard from I-70 to Jackson Gap Street.

DEN and their consultant team will be designing and constructing an annual maintenance project to repair Landside roadway infrastructure, including guardrail replacement, pavement replacement, shouldering repairs, and other miscellaneous repairs as identified. Partial funding for this project has been secured through the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) so the primary goal of the project will be to improve safety for all users of Peña Blvd.

Anticipated contractor notice to proceed in June 2025. This project aligns with Vision 100 by maintaining what we have and improving safety at DEN.

The grant award is for \$890,487 and for a term through January 13, 2035.
