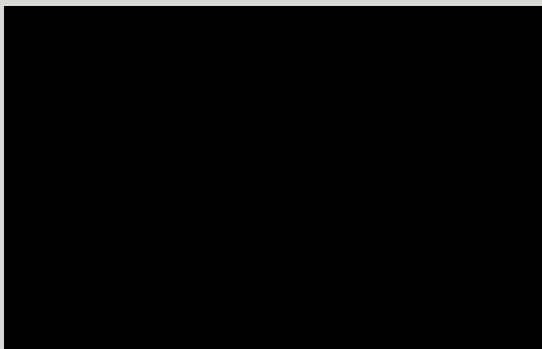

Biography:

Lewis “Keith” TallBull was born and raised in Denver, Colorado. The city has played an important part in his personal history, as it has for many urban American Indians. As a proud full-blooded Southern Cheyenne, his parents were from Oklahoma, and they were forced there by the United States government. Keith often thinks about how, from the Rocky Mountains east to the Missouri River, and from the Badlands south to the Arkansas River, it was all Cheyenne land.

His work in the community reminds him that while our stories are numerous within the urban American Indian community, many of us share the same struggles and triumphs. His family has been deeply involved in preserving and upholding cultural practices and spaces, not only in Denver but across the entire Front Range. Working and helping to support folks through cultural practices strengthens his family and community ties.

Relocation has stripped many people of these spaces and places but work with the broader Denver community starts to rebuild and reinforce positive cultural work. Through his stage, film, and improv background, Keith is a dynamic public speaker and well-versed in historical and cultural practices that make him widely sought after to attend events.
