Section 2.

- (A) There is hereby established in the Human Services Special Revenue Fund, Accounting No. 13000, a "Crime Prevention and Control Fund" Accounting Number 13821-5554000, for the purpose of supporting criminal justice planning activities and use of evidence-based programs and services to improve public safety.
- (B) Monies received from transfers from the General Fund as well as other contributions, donations, project incomes, interest earned, or other source of private receipts by the fund account described in subsection (A) of this Section 2 shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund No. 13000 which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver, and specifically to the "Crime Prevention and Control Fund program, Accounting No. 13821-5554000.
- (C) Expenditures are hereby authorized for the "Crime Prevention and Control Fund," program, Accounting No. 13821-5554000 in the amount not to exceed the total deposits described in subsection (B) of this Section 2, subject to review and recommendation by the Crime Prevention and Control Commission as required by section 2-255.58, D.R.M.C.
- (D) The Auditor and the Treasurer of the City and County of Denver are hereby authorized and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be necessary to accomplish the purpose of this Ordinance.

Section 3. The Ordinance shall be effective April, 2005.
