## 1 Update from the Office of Children's Affairs and the Denver Preschool Program.

Erin Brown, Director of the Office of Children's Affairs.

Erin Brown presented on the Office of Children's Affairs (OCA) and Jennifer Landrum presented on the Denver Preschool Program (DPP).

### Presentation(s) available online.

Denver issued citywide youth goals in 2012. The OCA seeks to fulfill these goals. Tuition for DPP is based on service level and income. DPP students of all races show better longitudal scores.

#### **Discussion:**

**Kniech:** The Housing and Homeless working group will be meeting on 6/23 at 2:00.

**Kashmann:** Why the increase in homeless youth? The increase in housing prices is a major contributor.

**Kniech:** Is every student that wants access to DPP gain access? Yes - all will receive some sort of credit. What is the teacher salary - related to quality of educators. DPP rewards teachers for high performance.

**Flynn:** Why the decline in populations when Denver is growing? Transitive populations and decreasing birth rates.
