6. General description of proposed ordinance including contract scope of work if applicable:

Air Canada qualifies for an air service incentive for their new service to Montreal (service initiation June 4, 2016). As an unserved destination in Canada, Air Canada’s service to Montreal qualifies for a waiver of fees, applied as credits, to operate at Denver International Airport for the first two years of this service. The maximum amount of the credits is \$1.5M over these two years and the exact waiver amount is based on the number of passengers carried (\$25 of waiver per enplaned passenger). This incentivizes Air Canada to carry as many passengers as possible on the flight.
