Department of Parks & Recreation Office of the City Forester

The Office of the City Forester (OFC) is seeking to establish a group of qualified contractors to provide on-call services for Tree Planting & Watering

Purpose and Use of Agreements:

The purpose is to establish and maintain a pool of qualified on-call contractors to respond to bidding requests for tree planting and watering services on city owned property.

Denver Parks and Recreation's Office of the City Forester's mission is to protect, preserve and renew its urban tree canopy. In an effort to preserve the ecological services Denver's urban tree canopy provides to the community, the City is actively planting new and replacement trees throughout public property within the City and County of Denver such as parks, parkways, public office space, within public right-of-way, etc.

On an as-needed basis, on-call Contractors will install/plant trees and also provide establishment watering for the new trees.

Procurement:

Five (5) companies submitted proposal which were reviewed and scored. Of those, three (3) companies were selected.

Contracts Description:

Each contract has a three (3) year term and a capacity of \$3,000,000. The companies selected for these agreements are listed alphabetically.

- SuperTrees Colorado LLC
- TigerTree, Inc.

These contracts do not commit funds, nor do they guarantee any amount to the firms. These contracts are not an authorization of work. Authorization or work and commitment of funds are made via work order on an as needed basis.
