



- **Who:** The GES Coalition
- **What:** The Plaza del Pueblo Event
- **Description:** Activated the N. Brighton Blvd corridor and brought together the GES neighborhoods and the National Western Center
- **Where:** 47th and Brighton
- **When:** October 8th, 2022 from 3-7pm
- **NAP Award:** \$60,192



Neighborhood Activation Program- Round 1 Highlights

- **Who:** West Colfax Business Improvement District
- **What:** Physical improvement/Beautification
- **Description:** first-time collaboration to implement beautification of commercial corridors through community designed murals, art corrals, and tree plantings
- **Where:** West Denver
- **When:** Fully completed by September 2023
- **NAP Award:** \$187,323
