9 For an ordinance submitting to a vote of the qualified and registered electors of the City
10 and County of Denver at a special municipal election to be held in conjunction with the
11 coordinated election of November 3, 2020, a proposed amendment to the Charter of the
12 City and County of Denver creating a Board of Transportation and Infrastructure

14 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

16 **Section 1.** There is hereby submitted to the registered electors of the City and County of
17 Denver for their approval or rejection at a special municipal election held in conjunction with the
18 coordinated election on November 3, 2020, a proposed amendment to the Charter of the City and
19 County of Denver, as follows:

21 **Effective upon publication and filing with the Secretary of State pursuant to the**
22 **Constitution and laws of the State of Colorado, the following sections of Article II of**
23 **the 2002 Charter of the City and County of Denver shall be and are hereby amended to**
24 **read as follows:**

26 Part 3 of Article II shall be amended to add a new section to read as follows:

27 **Part 3. – Transportation and Infrastructure**

28 **§2.3.5 – Board of Transportation and Infrastructure**

29 There is hereby created a Board of Transportation and Infrastructure (hereinafter called the
30 "Board") consisting of nineteen members. Six members of the Board shall be appointed by the
31 Mayor. Thirteen of the members shall be appointed by City Council. Members shall serve at the
32 pleasure of their respective appointing authorities. Members of the Board should represent a variety
33 of interests, backgrounds and geography. Members of the Board shall serve without pay. The
34 Board shall advise the Manager with respect to the policy and operation of the Department and
35 shall review and comment on the proposed annual budget for the Department.

2 **Section 2.** The ballot shall contain the following title and submission clause:

4 **REFERRED QUESTION _____**

5 Shall the Charter of the City and County of Denver be amended to create the Board of
6 Transportation and Infrastructure to advise the Manager with respect to the policy and
7 operation of the Department and shall review and comment on the proposed annual
8 budget for the Department?

11 **Section 3.** The proper officials of the City and County of Denver as are charged with duties
12 relating to the election shall, before the election, issue such calls, make such certifications and
13 publications, give such notices, make such appointments, and do all such other acts and things in
14 connection with the submission of this Charter amendment to the registered electors of the City and
15 County of Denver at the election as are required by the Constitution and laws of the State of
16 Colorado and the Charter and ordinances of the City and County of Denver.

17 **Section 4.** The ballots cast at such election shall be canvassed and the results ascertained,
18 determined, and certified in accordance with the requirements of the Constitution and laws of the
19 State of Colorado and the Charter and ordinances of the City and County of Denver.

20 **Section 5.** If any section, paragraph, clause, or other portion of this ordinance is held to be
21 invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance shall
22 not be affected.
