A RESOLUTION

Approving and providing for the execution of a proposed Grant Agreement between the City and County of Denver and the United States Department of Transportation Federal Highway Administration concerning the “Safe Streets and Roads for All Grant” program and the funding therefor.

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said proposed Grant Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The proposed Grant Agreement, under CFDA No. 20.939, between the City and County of Denver and the United States Department of Transportation Federal Highway Administration for the “Safe Streets and Roads for All Grant” program, which is identified as Grant Number 693JJ32340260, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 202368719, be and hereby is approved in all respects.

Section 2. The payments made by the Colorado Department of Transportation to the City pursuant to and under the Grant Agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund No. 38000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 3. That it be and is hereby found and determined that the budget summary of said program, to be expended by the Executive Director of the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure, is as follows:

Expenditures of said funds are authorized from July 31, 2023 to July 31, 2026. There is a City cash match of \$144,000 that is already appropriated.
