SUBJECT: Informational Item on 2024 Bundle of Text Amendments

Just like infrastructure needs maintenance to stay in top condition, the Denver Zoning Code also needs regular maintenance to continue to respond to the needs of the city, while remaining modern and flexible. Every few years, Community Planning and Development (CPD) proposes a "bundle" of text amendments to the Denver Zoning Code to reduce ambiguity, comply with state law, clean up errors, and revisit requirements in light of evolving city policies and priorities. In addition to the regular maintenance of the code, the 2024 Bundle aims to reduce zoning permitting times with a focus on simplifying standards and streamlining procedures.

Community Planning and Development recognizes that the 2024 Bundle touches nearly every corner of the Denver Zoning Code and consists of over 130 proposed changes. We will provide an informational session to provide background on the proposals in the Bundle and an opportunity for in-depth discussion of the changes proposed. At the October 22nd LUTI meeting, CPD will describe the goals of the amendment, focus in on certain amendments, and allow time for questions and discussion.
