CB11-0408 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Catholic Charities and Community Services of the Archdiocese of Denver, to allocate \$695,509.00 for Head Start services through December 31, 2011. (HEALTH, SAFETY, EDUCATION & SERVICES)

Allocates \$695,509.20 to Catholic Charities for Head Start services for 216 children and their families through December 31, 2011. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 7-18-11. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 6-2-11.

CB11-0409 A bill for an ordinance approving a proposed Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Clayton Family Futures, dba, Clayton Educare, to allocate \$564,832.00 for Head Start services through December 31, 2011. (HEALTH, SAFETY, EDUCATION & SERVICES)

Allocates \$564,832.14 to Clayton Educare for Head Start services for 204 children and their families through December 31, 2011. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 7-18-11. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 6-2-11.

Land Use, Transportation & Infrastructure

CB11-0426 AS AMENDED, a bill for an ordinance amending sub-section 11 of section 39-121 of the Revised Municipal Code changing various fees and charges for recreation centers and adding sub-paragraph e. regarding consumer price index adjustments. (LAND USE, TRANSPORTATION & INFRASTRUCTURE)

Approves the recreation center tiering model recommended by the Recreation Center Task Force, makes related fee and membership changes, and allows for annual fee adjustments up to CIP by the manager. Amended 6-27-11 to correct the title and body of the bill to apply the consumer price index adjustments only to recreation center fees and correct typographical errors. The Committee approved filing this bill at its meeting on 6-7-11.

CB11-0439 A bill for an ordinance approving a Second Amendment to Professional Services Agreement with Softball in Denver, Inc., to perform the officiating services for adult sports teams. (LAND USE, TRANSPORTATION & INFRASTRUCTURE)

Adds \$400,000 to the agreement with Softball in Denver, Inc. for a new total of \$562,000 for 4 years (through Dec. 31, 2013) to provide sports officials for the Adult Sports programs. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-

CB11-0448 A bill for an ordinance approving an amendatory on-call agreement between Roadsafe Traffic Systems, Inc. and the City & County of Denver for the 2011 Pavement Marking Project. (LAND USE, TRANSPORTATION & INFRASTRUCTURE)

Amends the on-call contract with Roadsafe Traffic Systems for pavement markings to extend the term one year and add \$1,000,000 for a new total of \$1,794,250. CB11-0449 AS AMENDED, a bill for an ordinance approving an agreement between ABCO Contracting, Inc. and the City and County of Denver for modifications of the 1st Avenue Bridge over Cherry Creek at Downing and the Cherry Creek Bike Trail. (LAND USE, TRANSPORTATION & INFRASTRUCTURE)

Approves a \$1,418,855 contract with ABCO Contracting for the project on the 1st Ave. Bridge over Cherry Creek at Downing and the Cherry Creek Bike Trail in Council District 10. Amended 6-27-11 to correct the title to accurately describe the location of the work to be performed by the contractor. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period in on 7-18-11. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 6-16-11.

CB11-0450 A bill for an ordinance relinquishing a certain drainage easement established in Lowry Filing No. 30. (LAND USE, TRANSPORTATION & INFRASTRUCTURE)

Relinquishes a drainage easement no longer required in Lowry Filing No. 30, at Ulster and Uinta in Council District 5. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 7-18-11. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 6-16-11.

CB11-0451 A bill for an ordinance relinquishing a utility easement established in the Subdivision Plat Bow-Mar Heights. (LAND USE, TRANSPORTATION & INFRASTRUCTURE)

Relinquishes an easement established in the Subdivision Plat for Bow-Mar Heights at W. Stanford and Quitman in Council District 2. The last regularly scheduled Council meeting within the 30-day review period is on 7-18-11. The Committee approved filing this bill by consent on 6-16-11.
