 - a. Scope of Work

This contract is for the Capital Improvement Project for the Warning Siren Replacement System, this covers the cash portion (non-financed portion) and is split between the CIP fund, 911 fund, and the DIA fund. The purpose of this project is to upgrade the City's outdoor warning siren system, used to notify the public of tornadoes or other emergencies that require immediate sheltering. 56 obsolete sirens will be replaced with modern sirens, and 21 existing sirens (including nine at DIA) will be upgraded to be compatible with the new system
