7 **Extending the declaration of local disaster emergency pertaining to**
8 **unsheltered residents filed with the clerk and recorder to August 21, 2023.**
9

10 **WHEREAS**, the City and County of Denver has experienced year over year increases in the
11 number of people experiencing homelessness, an increase in those experiencing first time
12 homelessness, and a tripling in the number of people experiencing unsheltered homelessness
13 since 2019;

14 **WHEREAS**, the 2022 Point in Time Count, an annual survey of the number of people
15 experiencing homelessness on a single night in January, counted over 1,300 City residents who
16 were unsheltered and living outdoors;

17 **WHEREAS**, the number of people living unsheltered in 2022 was the highest number ever
18 recorded in the City and all indications point to these numbers expanding again in 2023;

19 **WHEREAS**, the large number of people living unsheltered in the City creates significant public
20 health and safety risks due to the lack of available services and the associated impacts of
21 encampments created in spaces that are not safe for habitation;

22 **WHEREAS**, people who live unsheltered have higher rates of illness and shorter life spans
23 and living unsheltered is a dangerous health condition for individuals;

24 **WHEREAS**, the need to provide shelter, physical and behavioral health care services, and
25 other supportive services for the City's unsheltered residents is straining and exceeding current
26 City resources;

27 **WHEREAS**, the City faces a humanitarian crisis that requires it to take extraordinary
28 measures to meet the immediate needs of City residents living unsheltered;

29 **WHEREAS**, the City has requested financial and other assistance from the state government
30 as well as nonprofits and other community resources, including additional sheltering, physical and
31 behavioral health care services, and other supportive services;

32 **WHEREAS**, the City anticipates requesting financial and other assistance from the federal
33 government;

34 **WHEREAS**, people and property are at risk based on the number of individuals living
35 unsheltered and outdoors in the City, as described in the above paragraphs;

1 **WHEREAS**, the risks posed as described herein require preparation and arrangements for
2 housing, shelter, infrastructure, and other supportive services to protect the health, safety, or
3 welfare of people within the City described herein;

4 **WHEREAS**, on July 18, 2023, Mayor Johnston filed with the City and County of Denver Clerk
5 and Recorder a State of Local Disaster Emergency Declaration (hereinafter “Declaration”);

6 **WHEREAS**, the period of Declaration is currently in effect until Tuesday, July 25, 2023;

7 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to state law, Colo. Rev. Stat. §24-33.5-709 (1), the effect of the period
8 of local disaster emergency cannot exceed seven days except by or with the approval of City
9 Council;

10 **WHEREAS**, out of an abundance of caution, City Council intends to further extend the current
11 Declaration until Monday, August 21, 2023;

12 **WHEREAS**, the Declaration gives the City the ability to expedite procurement for critical
13 services and shelter for unsheltered residents living outdoors in the City, among other time-
14 sensitive needs.

15 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

16 **Section 1.** That the State of Local Disaster Emergency Declaration prepared by Mayor
17 Michael C. Johnston and filed with the Clerk and Recorder of the City and County of Denver on
18 July 18, 2023, be extended until August 21, 2023, and shall be in effect until terminated by the
19 Mayor or by City Council in accordance with state and local laws.
