The Continuum of Care Bedrock Program provides permanent supportive housing through two subcontracts with The Empowerment Program and WellPower. Each program serves a specific population:

- The Empowerment Program serves formerly justice involved women and trans people
- WellPower serves those with disabilities.

These programs provide permanent housing and culturally relevant case management for people who would otherwise struggle to find and maintain affordable housing.
