Scope of work:

Ferkham, Inc. dba Extreme Towing & Recovery provides comprehensive towing services for the Denver Police Department, Denver Sheriff's Department and Denver Right of Way Enforcement and other city agencies.

This contract resulted from an RFP conducted in 2016. These services include all tows to the Vehicle Impound Facility at 5160 York Street. Additional scope of work includes the towing of damaged or disabled City vehicles, to include standard and heavy tows; working with ROWE, DSD, DPD to clear traffic lanes; and controlling parking during home Bronco games.

This contract provides services for towing City-owned vehicles as well as those vehicles which are abandoned and confiscated and subsequently towed to the city's Vehicle Impound Facility. This contract is separate from the Citizen Towing Contracts that have multiple vendors. The Citizen Towing Contractors respond to accident scenes, where DPD personnel do have to wait for the vehicle to be towed; however, those accident vehicles are generally not towed to the City's Impound facility.
