# THE DEDICATION PROCESS

Why and how this process occurs in Denver

**Resolution Request 2024 - 1013** 



## Why Do Dedications Occur?

- 1) Project-related: Resolution Request 24-1013
  - Project (2024-DEDICATION-0000032) scrapes an existing commercial building & constructs two mixed-use (commercial & retail) structures.
  - DOTI Transportation requires the developer dedicate land as Public Alley.
  - Dedications are often **slivers of land** to needed to widen the street and/or alley to meet current standards.
- 2) Remnant parcel cleanup: Example 2024-DEDICATION-0000153
  - Survey staff found several alleys and portions of streets that were deeded to the city in 1974 but were never formally Dedicated as Public Right-of-Way. This process formalizes the Dedication.



### **How does DOTI Process a Dedication?**

#### **Development Review Process**

- DOTI Transportation identifies if additional right-of-way is required to meet transportation & mobility needs.
- Developer conveys the land to the City and County of Denver.
- DOTI Survey & Real Estate review conveyance for accuracy.
- Staff submits the Request for Resolution packet when conveyance is ready for formal Dedication.
- After the Dedication is recorded, DOTI Addressing will notify Real Estate, Survey-GIS and Assessor.
- These entities update their records and/or GIS data.



### What is Resolution Request 24-1013:

#### 2024-DEDICATION-000032

- Dedication of land as Right-of-Way to ensure the public has access for transportation & mobility needs as it relates to the extent of the development project.
- Requires 2 ft x 225 ft of new Public Alley
