This agreement establishes the City's rates for the disposal of non-municipal waste, including construction, industrial, remedial rubbish, debris, clean dirt, and other waste materials generated by the city, including the Denver International Airport, and its subcontractors, at the at the city-owned landfill, the Denver Arapahoe Disposal Site (DADS), which is operated by WM pursuant to an associated Landfill Agreement. This amendatory agreement generates savings for the City as the rates set forth therein are consistent and competitive with rates at other Denver Metro area non-hazardous waste landfills and, as required by Section 8.2 of the Landfill Agreement, are the lowest, best, gate rates.

In the agreement, Denver agrees to direct unrecycled waste collected or hauled in Denver vehicles to the Facility for disposal. Denver also agrees to direct its contractors and subcontractors to direct unrecycled waste from Denver owned or controlled facilities to DADS for disposal. Executive Order 115 (Required use of DADS) establishes the policy of the City and County of Denver to assure compliance with the City's obligations outlined in the Landfill Agreement. This policy ensures that City activities associated with the collection, transportation and disposal of non-hazardous waste are consistent with the City Charter and Agreements to protect the financial interests of the City, minimize potential liability for site remediation costs under the Comprehensive Environmental Response Cleanup Liability Act (CERCLA), and protect human health and the environment.
