Both appropriations were made in the 2013 budget to address potential local match requirements and are no longer needed. \$350K was appropriated to potentially address the operations and maintenance of Pena Boulevard as a result of non-airport traffic attributable to Denver. Denver International Airport has secured grant funding to address this need. \$500K was appropriated as a local match placeholder for a federal grant application to support the implementation of the 16 th Street Mall Master Plan.
