A BILL

For an ordinance approving a proposed Intergovernmental Agreement between the City and County of Denver and Trustees of the Colorado Firefighter Heart and Cancer Benefits Trust to allow Denver Firefighters to join the Voluntary Cancer Benefits Award Program, in place of the City’s self-insured and self-administered Workers’ Compensation program.
