A BILL

For an ordinance designating certain property as “park” under section 2.4.5 of the city charter, namely Hampden Heights West Park.

WHEREAS, the following real property, known as Hampden Heights West Park, which is under the jurisdiction of the Denver Department of Parks and Recreation has been or will be used for park purposes within the City and County of Denver (“Park Property”):

That Part of Tract C, Hampden Heights West, lying East of a line that is 845 feet East of the North – South centerline of Section 33, T 4 S, R 67 W, of the 6th P.M., City and County of Denver, State of Colorado.

And also,

Tracts A, B, D, E and F,
Dartmouth Downs,
City and County of Denver,
State of Colorado.

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board and the Manager of Parks and Recreation have recommended that said Park Property be formally designated as a “park” under section 2.4.5 of the City Charter.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. That the Park Property, known as Hampden Heights West Park, is hereby designated as a “park” under section 2.4.5 of the City Charter and shall henceforth be regarded as being a designated park in the City and County of Denver, the designation being subject to an existing Colorado Interstate Gas Company Gas Easement, an existing Public Service Company Gas Easement, and any existing utilities lawfully located in the Park Property as of the date of this park designation.
