Section 1. - (a) A local maintenance district providing for the continuing care, operation, repair,

 created by Ordinance No. 39, Series of 2002 and amended by Ordinance No. 843, Series 2003;
- (b) The annual cost of the continuing care, operation, repair, maintenance and

 Manager of Public Works has the authority to expend for the purposes stated herein;
- (c) The Manager of Public Works has complied with all provisions of law relating to the

 complaints and objections, if any, filed with the Manager of Public Works;
- (d) The real property within the West 44th Avenue and Eliot Street Pedestrian Mall will be
 benefited in an amount equal to or in excess of the amount to be assessed against said property
 because of the continuing care, operation, repair, maintenance and replacement of said Pedestrian
 Mall.
- **Section 2.** The annual cost of the continuing care, operation, repair, maintenance and replacement of the West 44th Avenue and Eliot Street Pedestrian Mall to be assessed against the real properties, exclusive of improvements thereon, benefited are hereby approved.
- 34 **Section 3.** As the West 44th Avenue and Eliot Street Pedestrian Mall currently has sufficient 35 reserves to pay for the 2014 annual costs of the continuing care, operation, repair, maintenance
