Section 18-175 of the Revised Municipal Code pertaining to the City's 14 contribution to the dental insurance program, is hereby amended to read as follows: 15 16 For the Calendar year 2011 2012 and thereafter, the City will contribute monthly for dental 17 insurance for eligible employees and appointed charter officers: 18 19 (a) ninety five (95) Eighty Five (85) percent of the monthly premium of the lowest cost plan for 20 employee only plans; ninety (90) seventy-seven and one-half (77.5) percent of the monthly 21 premium of the lowest cost plan for employee plus partner plans; ninety (90) eighty (80) percent of 22 the monthly premium of the lowest cost plan for employee plus children plans; and eighty-five (85) 23 seventy-five (75) percent of the monthly premium of the lowest cost plan for family plans, 24 regardless of the plan selected by the employee, for eligible employees who are regularly 25 scheduled to work at least eighty (80) hours every two (2) weeks. 26 27 (b) Seventy-one and one-quarter (71.25) Sixty-three and three-quarter (63.75) percent of the 28 monthly premium of the lowest cost plan for employee only plans; sixty-seven and one-half (67.5) 29 Fifty-eight and one-eight (58.125) percent of the monthly premium of the lowest cost plan for 30 employee plus partner plans; sixty-seven and one half (67.5) sixty (60) percent of the monthly 31 premium of the lowest cost plan for employee plus children plans; and sixty-three and three-32 quarter (63.75) fifty-six and one-quarter (56.25) percent of the monthly premium of the lowest cost 33 plan for family plans, regardless of the plan selected by the employee, for eligible employees who 34 are regularly scheduled to work at least sixty (60) but less than eighty (80) hours every two (2)
