Executive Summary

Volunteers of America (VOA) is a national non-profit, faith-based organization dedicated to helping those in need to rebuild their lives and reach their full potential. They oversee more than 30 human service programs and help support and empower Denver's most vulnerable groups including low-income families and homeless individuals and families. This project provides \$620,000 of CDBG funds for the acquisition and related soft costs associated with the construction of a new early childhood education center in the Westwood neighborhood.

Since 2003, VOA has provided early childhood education (ECE) for extremely low income children ages 3-5 in a church gymnasium at 3440 West Louisiana in the Westwood neighborhood. The current space does not allow service to more than 68 children at a time. Currently VOA has a lengthy waitlist of eligible children. The newly constructed ECE Center will serve 170 low income households with high quality early childhood programs. The new ECE center will also allow VOA to expand services to infants and toddlers in addition to being able to provide before and after school care for nearby residents.

This performance based loan, to be secured by a Deed of Trust on the property, will be forgiven after the term of the loan (7 years) as long as the facility continues to serve low and moderate income persons for those seven years.
