

## Commending Denver Media Services and Denver 8 for placing First in City Council meeting coverage at the National Government Programming Awards

**WHEREAS,** Denver Media Services has covered City Council meetings for 27 years, beginning in 1986, to provide transparency in government processes, educate viewers, and encourage civic participation; and

**WHEREAS**, coverage of City Council and committee meetings reaches more residents than ever before as videos are now available on Comcast Denver 8 and online at DenverGov.org; and

**WHEREAS**, surveyed residents indicate increased trust in government because they can view their elected officials in action on Denver 8 and DenverGov.org; and

**WHEREAS**, the National Association of Telecommunications Officers and Advisors has repeatedly recognized Denver Media Services for outstanding video productions at the Government Programming Awards including a First Place award for public meeting coverage at the organization's recent annual awards ceremony—a designation that represents an unprecedented tenth consecutive year for Denver's first place finish; and

**WHEREAS,** Denver Media Services competes with leading American cities in this category including Seattle, Washington, Phoenix, Arizona, Washington, DC, and New York City, New York; and

**WHEREAS**, the successful partnership between Denver City Council and Denver Media Services produces vital live and on-demand programming that is sure to "extend the run" of victory at future Government Programming Awards.
