Business, Workforce & Sustainability

BR13- Extends the Minority Women and Business Enterprise (MWBE) and Small Business Enterprise Ordinances (SBE) for an additional three (3) months through April 1, 2014.

Government & Finance

- BR13- Approves a one-year, \$650,000 contract with HSI, Health System 0815 International, for pharmacy benefit management services for the Denver workers' compensation program through December 31, 2014 (CE05007).
- BR13- Approves a one-year, \$600,000 contract with CorVel Corporation for bill review and re-pricing services for the City's workers' compensation program (CE06002).
- BR13- Approves the appropriations' ordinance establishing the City's 2014 0818 Annual Budget (Long Bill).
- BR13- Approves an up to three-year, \$2,000,000 Master Purchase Order with Northern Barricade Co. for barricades and traffic control devices and services (0794A0113).
- BR13- Approves an up to three-year \$650,000 Master Purchase Order with Colorado Barricade Co. for barricades and traffic control devices and services (0794A0213).
- BR13- Approves a one-year, no-cost extension of the contract with Woolpert, 0831 Inc. for on-call professional services (201102807-01).
- BR13- Approves a five-year, \$5 lease agreement with Denver Housing 0817 Authority for Neighborhood House (within Lincoln Park) at 1265 Mariposa Street to facilitate the sublessee's provision of educational services to public housing and neighborhood children and youth.

Health, Safety, Education & Services

- BR13- Approves a contract amendment for \$2,108,367 using American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) grant funds for Populus, LLC which will provide loan program advising, customer support, data management, work flow management, energy advising, energy advisor training, and other project management support for the Denver Energy Challenge Program (ENVHL-201204731-00).
- BR13- Approves amending the contract with Denver Municipal Defenders, P.C. to add one year through December 31, 2014, and to add \$209,220.36 for legal representation of indigent defendants charged with municipal offenses and who face the possibility of a jail sentence.
- BR13- Approves a contract with the Law Offices of Frank Moya for one year 0814 through December 31, 2014, in the amount of \$525,000, for legal representation of indigent defendants charged with municipal offenses and who face the possibility of a jail sentence (201313489).
- BR13- Approves a contract with Colorado Health Network, Inc., doing business as Colorado Aids Project (CAP), to provide housing opportunities and related support services to low income households affected by HIV/AIDS from Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) grant funds in the amount of \$1,100,000.
- BR13- Approves a fifth amendment to the Xerox State and Local Solutions, 0826 Inc. contract to add one year through December 31, 2014, and to add \$150,000 for the continuance of the Automated Photo Red Light Program (CE-01061-05).
- BR13- Amends the contract with the Colorado Nonprofit Development Center to add one year through December 31, 2014 and to add \$543,283.50 to support jail to community reentry services (SAFTY-201208794-01).
- RR13- Approves the Mayoral appointment of Alexis Menocal Harrigan to the Denver Latino Commission effective immediately and expiring on January 1, 2015, or until a successor is duly appointed.

Routine, non-controversial requests for ordinances that are not substantive policy changes may be placed on Consent Agendas for Council Committees each week with the approval of Committee chairs. Councilmembers receive the consent agendas for review and have until Thursday at noon to request that an item be scheduled for Committee discussion. If approved, items are placed on the Mayor-Council agenda the following week. This document outlines the items that were placed on consent agendas this week.
