A RESOLUTION

Concerning adoption of the Storm Drainage Master Plan for the City and County of Denver.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 56-110 of the Denver Revised Municipal Code, the Executive Director of Public Works has formulated and developed the Storm Drainage Master Plan for the City and County of Denver based on expert engineering studies which replaces and supersedes the Master Drainage Plan dated September 2014 that was previously adopted by Council Resolution 0188, Series of 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Storm Drainage Master Plan describes major drainage ways and facilities and studies future needs required to provide for drainage and control of surface waters within the City's major drainage basins; and

WHEREAS, Section 56-110(e) of the Denver Revised Municipal Code provides that the master drainage plan formulated and developed by the Executive Director of Public Works may not be considered the official master drainage plan of the City until it is adopted by resolution of the city council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The City and County of Denver hereby adopts the Storm Drainage Master Plan, dated October 2019, and filed in the office of the Clerk and Recorder, Ex-Officio Clerk of the City and County of Denver, under City Clerk's Filing No. 20190085. as the official master drainage plan of the City.
