DEPENDENCY SUMMONS

This summons is initiated pursuant to Rule 4 of the Colorado Rules of Civil Procedure and §19-3-503 of the Colorado Revised Statutes (C.R.S. (2017)).

TO THE RESPONDENTS: You are hereby notified that a petition has been filed which alleges that the above named child is dependent or neglected as per the facts set forth in paragraph six of the Dependency or Neglect Petition, a copy of which is attached hereto.

A hearing has been set for **February 28, 2018 at 1:30 p.m., in Denver Juvenile Court, Courtroom 2C**, in the City and County of Denver, State of Colorado, on the second floor of the Lindsey-Flanigan Courthouse, 520 W. Colfax Ave., Denver Colorado, 80204.

Your presence before this Court is required to defend against the claims in this petition. **IF YOU FAIL TO APPEAR, THE COURT WILL PROCEED IN YOUR ABSENCE, WITHOUT FURTHER NOTICE, TO CONDUCT AN ADJUDICATORY HEARING AND MAY ENTER A JUDGMENT BY DEFAULT THEREBY ADJUDICATING YOUR CHILD A DEPENDENT OR NEGLECTED CHILD.**

You have the right to request a trial by jury at the adjudicatory stage of this petition. You have the right to a hearing before a judge in all stages of this proceeding, with the exception of detention hearings held pursuant to §19-3-403, 6 C.R.S. (2017). If you waive your right to a hearing before a judge, you will be bound by the findings and recommendations of the magistrate, subject to a request for review. If you fail to request a hearing before the judge at the time the hearing is set, or within five days of receiving notice that a hearing has been set before the magistrate, your right to a hearing before the judge will be deemed waived. You also have the right to legal representation at every stage of the proceedings by counsel of your own choosing or, if you are without sufficient financial means, appointment of counsel by the Court. Termination of your parent-child legal relationship to free your child for adoption is a possible remedy in this proceeding. If that remedy is pursued, you are entitled to a hearing before a Judge. You also have the right, if you are indigent, to have the Court appoint, at no expense to you, one expert witness of your own choosing at any hearing on the termination of your parent-child legal relationship. If you are a minor, you have the right to the appointment of a guardian *ad litem* to represent your best interests.
