

Proclamation No. CP11-0260

In Recognition of Library Appreciation Week April 10-16

WHEREAS, National Library Week is an annual celebration of the contributions of our nation's libraries and librarians; and

WHEREAS, the Denver Public Library connects people with information, ideas, and experiences to provide enjoyment, enrich lives, and strengthen our community; and

WHEREAS, thanks to the voter-approved Better Denver Bond Program, the Denver Public Library renovated eight Library branches; is in the process of renovating three additional locations; opened the beautiful new Green Valley Ranch Branch Library; and is preparing to construct two more branches in Stapleton and West Denver - to better serve the residents of our City; and

WHEREAS, the Denver Public Library has become a critical resource for job seekers, where customers can find help with creating a resume, completing an online job application, or learn about successful interview techniques; and

WHEREAS, the Library provides customers with resources such as BizBoost - a business research solutions support desk - and one-on-one assistance to find resources about opening a new business; and

WHEREAS, the Denver Public Library has something for *everyone*, from books and DVDs, to digital media, and computer classes - all for free; and

WHEREAS, the Denver Public Library has friendly, knowledgeable staff who are passionate about helping people; and

WHEREAS, the Denver Public Library makes an extraordinary difference in our community and is VITAL to the economic growth and success of our City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER THAT:

Section 1. That the Council hereby proclaims the week of April 10 through April 16, 2011, as Library Appreciation Week.

Section 2. That the Clerk of the City and County of Denver shall attest and affix the seal of the City and County of Denver to this proclamation.
