Amendment to the Colorado Symphony Orchestra Association's lease of the Boettcher Concert Hall; revising the end date of the term from 08/31/2015 to 05/31/2015 and reducing the rental fee to \$1 per year effective July 1, 2014. All other terms and conditions within the contract remain in effect.
