6 **A BILL**

8 **For an ordinance establishing a new fund in the General Government Special**  
9 **Revenue Fund for “State Grants”.**

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11  
12 **WHEREAS**, the City currently lacks a special revenue fund to receive state grants in the  
13 General Government Series for general government special purposes or activities not covered by  
14 other funds;

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16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF**  
17 **DENVER:**

19 **Section 1.** A new fund is hereby established in the General Government Special Revenue  
20 Fund, Accounting No. 11000, a “State Grants” Fund, Accounting No. 11955 for the purpose of  
21 accounting for the receipt and expenditure of state grants awarded for general government  
22 purposes.

23 **Section 2.** Monies received from state awards for general government purposes shall be  
24 deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Revenue Fund No. 11000, which is  
25 set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of  
26 Denver.


27 **Section 3.** Expenditures are hereby authorized for the “State Grants” Fund, Accounting No.  
28 11955, in the amount not to exceed the amounts awarded by the state grantors as described in  
29 Section 2 of this Ordinance, to be expended by the Mayor or his or her designate or other  
30 authorized officials. This is a non-lapsing fund.

31 **Section 4.** The Chief Financial Officer of the City and County of Denver is hereby authorized  
32 and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be  
33 necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
