The purpose of the amendment is to extend the term of this Transportation and Mobility Professional Services Master On-Call Agreement by two years, through September 27, 2021. There is no change to the capacity of this Master On-Call Agreement. The amendment will also reference the updated Minimum Wage Protection Sections 20-82 through 20-84 D.R.M.C.

The benefit of this extension is to provide a continuity of service, coordination, close-out, and audit of open task orders that support the Public Works Capital Program and Infrastructure needs that are federally funded. The additional time will ensure continuation of services while we are assessing the number of contracts needed for the anticipated workload. It will also provide time for Public Works to establish a stronger equity program to be used in the selection of the new consultant teams.
