a. Scope of Work

This grant agreement will provide funding for the implementation of the River Vision Implementation Plan (RVIP) to improve the regional trail, create and enhance habitat within the river and along its banks, increase recreational access and promote educational opportunities. The limits of the project are from W Iliff north to W Florida and from W Mississippi north to W Alameda. Sources of local match funding include CCD, Urban Drainage and Flood Control District, The Greenway Foundation, CDPHE, Colorado Division of Wildlife and Colorado Water Conservation Board.

This ordinance establishes a capital grant fund number and appropriates \$4,600,000 to be received from Great Outdoors Colorado (GOCO). This ordinance will set up a capital grant fund and appropriate the budget for this grant as follows:
