


Passenger Traffic Trends

- 13-percent growth in international passenger traffic in CY 2013
 - Overall passenger traffic at DEN declined by one percent in 2013
- 20-percent growth in international passenger traffic YTD May 2014
 - Overall passenger traffic growth of two percent
- 30-percent increase in international destinations served nonstop over the past three years
 - Asia: Tokyo
 - Europe: Reykjavik
 - Caribbean: Punta Cana, Montego Bay
 - Mexico: Guadalajara, Chihuahua
 - Central America: Panama City



Duty Free Snapshot

- Current international departure activity (CY 2014)
 - Concourse A Europe, Caribbean, Mexico
 - Concourse B Asia, Caribbean, Mexico,
 Central America
 - Concourse C Mexico
- Current duty free footprint
 - Concourse A, Center Core Liberty Duty Free; 1,011 square feet
 - Concourse B, East Center Core Liberty Duty Free Kiosk; 45 square feet
- Designated future duty free/paid footprint
 - Concourse A, Center Core 2,315 square feet
 - Concourse B, Center Core Mezzanine 2,328 square feet
 - Concourse C, Center Core 1,390 square feet (Option for DF/DP)



Contract Description

- Concept: Tax & Duty Free/Duty Paid & Specialty Retail
- Location: A & B Gates Tax & Duty Free/Duty Paid
 - C Gates (Specialty Retail)
- Contract term: 7 years
- Projected opening date: June, 2015
- Projected Year 1 Sales: \$7,662,610
- Projected Employees: 37+
- Projected Annual Rent: \$1,401,592
- ACDBE goal/participation: 33% / 33%



Economic Benefits

- \$7.6M in annual revenues
- \$1.4M in annual rents to DIA plus percentage rent
- \$275K in annual sales tax to CCD
- 37 full and part-time employees
- 30 construction jobs
- ACDBE goals are set by the OED Division of Small Business
 Opportunity (DSBO)
- Approximately \$2.3M in newly recognized annual ACDBE revenues

Selection Process

- RFP issued October 2013 for Concession Opportunity -
 - -Tax and Duty Free/Duty Paid (Concourses A & B)
 - -Specialty Retail Sale of Perfumes, Cosmetics & Fashion Accessories (Concourse C)
- 33% ACDBE Goal / 33% participation
- -The successful proposer is Dufry North America, LLC
 - Operates tax- and duty-free locations nationwide in Newark Liberty, Houston Intercontinental, Chicago O'Hare and Seattle-Tacoma International Airports
 - Has a large portfolio of specialty retail brands in airports such as JFK, LAX, LAS, DFW and Newark

Our New Partners

- Denver Duty Free JV is a Joint Partnership between
 - Dufry North America, LLC (67%)
 - Odd Tale Books, LLC (23% ACDBE Participation)
 - Responsible for the management, control and direction of the Concourse C location and duty free warehouse
 - Dawn Bookhardt, currently is a joint venture partner with Hudson Group at DIA in nine duty paid locations, including newsstands and four bookstores

- Wystone's World Teas Holdings, Inc. (10% ACDBE Participation)
 - Responsible for the management, control and direction of the Concourse C location and duty free warehouse
 - Wy Livingston is the developer of Wystone's World Teas product and brand
