OED provided a \$1M to Colorado Health & Science Ecosystem, LLC in 2014 to fund a portion of the real estate acquisition located at 3825 Lafayette to develop and create a health tech collaborative office and mixed-use development. Due to a changed in the partnership structure and design/permitting process which resulted in the delay of the project development, the borrower has requested to amend the following in order to proceed and complete the development: (1) release two of the personal guarantors, (2) extend the deadline date to create the required 29 jobs from Oct. 2016 to July 2017, and (3) exchange the loan collateral from the current 3825 Lafayette Deed of Trust to a new Deed of Trust on 621 Kalamath Street. **These contract changes do not diminish OED's security position with respect to this project or this loan.**

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Executive Summary

Purpose: Request for approval of an amendment to an existing OED loan provided in September 2014 to Colorado Health & Science Ecosystem, LLC in the original amount of \$1.0 million which funded a portion of the real estate acquisition of 3825 Lafayette Street in Denver to develop and create a health tech collaborative office and mixed use development.

Contract Entity: Colorado Health & Science Ecosystem, LLC

Contract Amount: \$1,000,000

Location: 3825 Lafayette Street, Denver, CO 80005

Description: The development project has been delayed due to a change in the partnership structure and design/permitting approval process. In order to proceed and complete the development project, the borrower has requested to amend the following issues:

- (1) Release two personal guarantors: Sean Michael Campbell and Joshua James Marinos.
- (2) Extend the deadline date to create the required 29 new permanent full-time employees, of which 51% are to be low/moderate income individuals.
- (3) Exchange the loan collateral from the current Deed of Trust on 3825 Lafayette Street to a new Deed of Trust on 621 Kalamath Street in Denver, with permissible prior encumbrances of \$3.5 million.

These contract changes do not diminish OED's security position with respect to this project or this loan.
