RFP GS11136 was a competitive process to award multiple contracts for multiple phases of energy efficiency related work (audits à implementation of selected efficiency measures). • The original plan to use an Energy Performance Contract as the subsequent contract mechanism did not happen, as the city chose to pay cash via CASR for the next phase instead. So, while the general spirit of the competitive RFP is the same, the contract mechanism is slightly different.						
As such, the contracts are shown as "Sole Source" contracts in Jaggaer and come with a sole source justification.						
In 2023, 4 out of 7 Energy Service Companies were awarded contracts to perform energy audits in CCD buildings. Schneider Electric Buildings Americas, Inc. was one of the awardees. As a part of their ASHRAE Level 2 energy audits they developed cost estimates, design work, and guarantees of performance for energy conservation measures for Denver Arts & Venues sites. To preserve the value of the existing the design work and maintain the guarantees of performance, a sole source contract will be extended to Schneider. This sole source agreement is consistent with the goals, scope and requirements of RFP GS 11136.
