- 5. Describe the proposed ordinance, including what the proposed ordinance is intended to accomplish, who's involved
  - a. Scope of Work

The City is the "airport operator" of Denver International Airport (DIA) and is regulated by the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) under the relevant portions of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 49, Parts 1500 through 1562. Due to the unique nature and scope of the security objectives of the City at DIA, it is essential that the Security Personnel provided pursuant to this contract and amendment be professional, well trained, highly motivated, with minimal turnover, and directed by an engaged effective management team that thrives towards continual improvement and 'best practices'. Security guards are to be responsible for federal regulatory compliance at DIA. Significant additions proposed by the Amendment include the RTD EcoPass program, increases in PTO, and an increase to the billable rate. These increases would not require additional funds to the maximum liability.
