4 **A RESOLUTION**

5 **Revoking the revocable permit granted by Resolution No. 20180295, Series of**  
6 **2018 to New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC d/b/a AT&T Wireless.**

7 **WHEREAS**, the Permittee, New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC d/b/a AT&T Wireless, requests  
8 that the revocable permit granted by Resolution No. 20180295, Series of 2018 (“Permit”), be revoked  
9 and further waives the right to a public hearing;

10 **WHEREAS**, the Permittee is being granted a new revocable permit pursuant to Resolution  
11 No. 20210358, Series of 2021 (“New Permit”) concurrent with this revocation, which will replace the  
12 Permit.

13 **WHEREAS**, all sub-encroachment permits, such as Tier II encroachment permits, tied to and  
14 issued under the authority of the Permit will now be tied to and considered issued under the authority  
15 of the New Permit.

16 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:**

17 **Section 1.** That the Permit granted by Resolution No. 20180295, Series of 2018, is hereby  
18 revoked.

19 **Section 2.** All sub-encroachment permits, such as Tier II encroachment permits, tied to and  
20 issued under the authority of the Permit will now be tied to and considered issued under the authority  
21 of the New Permit pursuant to Resolution No. 20210358, Series of 2021, which is being granted  
22 concurrent with this revocation.
