6. **General description of proposed ordinance including contract scope of work if applicable:**

This ordinance approves an Intergovernmental Agreement with RTD that provides for the construction of the 35th St. Pedestrian Bridge which spans the Union Pacific and RTD East Corridor Rail. The agreement also contemplates the City’s acquisition of land for the relocated Union Pacific Rail Yard Office, and numerous easements necessary for the bridge construction and Yard Office relocation.

This ordinance also establishes a capital grant fund number and appropriates \$1,350,000 to be received from the Regional Transportation District (RTD) towards the construction of the 35th and 36th pedestrian bridge.
