AMENDATORY AGREEMENT

This **AMENDATORY AGREEMENT** is made between the **CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER**, a municipal corporation of the State of Colorado (the "City") and **THE RECIPROCITY COLLECTIVE**, a Colorado nonprofit corporation, whose address is 1043 East 20th Avenue, Denver, Colorado 80205 (the "Contractor"), jointly ("the Parties").

RECITALS:

- A. The Parties entered into an Agreement dated February 10, 2025, (the Agreement") to perform, and complete all of the services and produce all the deliverables set forth on Exhibit A, Scope of Work, to the City's satisfaction.
- **B.** The Parties wish to amend the Agreement to increase the maximum contract amount, update paragraph 18-Notices, and update scope of work exhibit.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the Parties' mutual covenants and obligations, the Parties agree as follows:

1. Section 4 of the Agreement entitled "<u>COMPENSATION AND PAYMENT</u>:", subsection **d.** entitled "<u>Maximum Contract Amount</u>:", sub-subsection (1) is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with:

"d. Maximum Contract Amount:

- (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of the Agreement, the City's maximum payment obligation will not exceed **NINE HUNDRED SEVEN THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED EIGHTY-TWO DOLLARS AND SEVENTY-FIVE CENTS (\$907,482.75)** (the "Maximum Contract Amount"). The City is not obligated to execute an Agreement or any amendments for any further services, including any services performed by Contractor beyond that specifically described in **Exhibit A**. Any services performed beyond those in **Exhibit A** are performed at Contractor's risk and without authorization under the Agreement."
- 2. Section 18 of the Agreement entitled "**NOTICES**:" is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with:
- "18. NOTICES: All notices required by the terms of the Agreement must be hand delivered, sent by overnight courier service, mailed by certified mail, return receipt requested,

or mailed via United States mail, postage prepaid, if to Contractor at the address first above written,

and if to the City at:

Notices hand delivered or sent by overnight courier are effective upon delivery. Notices sent by

certified mail are effective upon receipt. Notices sent by mail are effective upon deposit with the

U.S. Postal Service. The Parties may designate substitute addresses where or persons to whom

notices are to be mailed or delivered. However, these substitutions will not become effective until

actual receipt of written notification."

3. **Exhibit A** is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with **Exhibit A-1**, **Scope of**

Work, attached and incorporated by reference herein. All references in the original Agreement

to Exhibit A are changed to Exhibit A-1.

4. As herein amended, the Agreement is affirmed and ratified in each and every

particular.

5. This Amendatory Agreement will not be effective or binding on the City until it has

been fully executed by all required signatories of the City and County of Denver, and if required

by Charter, approved by the City Council.
