


## A CITY IN FULL COLOR

Arts and culture shape Denver's identity—driving the economy, inspiring pride, learning, change, and daily life.

- Residents overwhelmingly believe arts and culture create active,
   unique neighborhoods (87%), attract tourism (86%) and improve
   quality of life (84%).
- Nearly three-quarters (73%) of Denver residents view the city as an "arts town," highlighting the cultural sector's integral role in Denver's identity.





#### CULTURAL PLANNING IN DENVER

**Strategic planning** is key to shaping a city's creative future and serves as a framework and practical guide to strengthen and grow the arts and culture ecosystem.

#### RESEARCH METHODOLOGY



DENVER CREATES was built on comprehensive, inclusive research and provides a framework that serves as a practical guide to strengthen and grow the city's arts and culture ecosystem.

Key steps of the in-depth and statistically valid research included:

- Community Engagement: Over 2,500 voices were heard.
- Arts and Culture Sector-Specific Research: More than 100 in-depth interviews were conducted.
- Supplemental Data Analysis: Trends in participation and funding were examined.
- Collaborative Planning: Community advisors, focus groups and targeted outreach ensured representation.

- Arts and culture in neighborhoods





- Training for youth and early-career artists



Through DENVER CREATES, Denver Arts & Venues (DAV) aims to inspire collaboration within the arts community to collectively address sector challenges and bring the vision of this roadmap to life.


DAV will steward DENVER CREATES and serve as a convener of the cultural sector through programs like:

- Biannual Summit
- Speaker Series
- Impact Teams
- Year in Review Reports

#### DAV'S INITIATIVES



In addition to stewarding **DENVER CREATES**, **Denver Arts & Venues** (DAV) will launch initiatives to support specific actions identified by the community, focusing on:



- Stimulating creative economy
- Strategies for arts sector amplification
- Exploring cultural trust model
- Supporting youth arts programs
- Launch cultural partner program

#### **ARTS AND YOUTH**

- \$30,000 investment
- Partnership with Denver Parks & Recreation
- Youth 12 y/o and up
- Out-of-school-time arts & culture
- La Alma Recreation Center
  - Night Moves Arts & Culture 71 youth participants June August
  - Additional Fall programming planned



#### **IMPACT TEAM**

First team's focus: Sector Branding/Marketing

- Facilitated conversation: Alchemy Group
  - September 5, 2025
- Brought together a group of arts and culture stakeholders to identify priority areas and determine a path forward for our first Impact Team



#### CAST

- CAST Community Arts Stabilization Trust
- CAST (Oakland) expands its work in Colorado to create more sustainability for artists and cultural organizations
- DAV will host CAST's Colorado office at Champa Arts
- Collaborative effort including Bonfils Stanton
   Foundation and others
