Two Sergeants with DPD's Traffic Bureau will oversee the Distracted Driving and Speed Enforcement grant. For Speed Enforcement, officer overtime will be utilized to conduct operations 7 days a week with varying hours to address egregious speeding. Due to the influx of street racing across the metro area as well as ordinary speeding on the highway system it is imperative to conduct enforcement during all times of the day or night across 7 days a week. For Distracted Driving, officer overtime will be utilized to conduct operations at identified hot spots for high incidents of distracted driving through available data from the DPD Analytical Services Bureau. The days and hours will vary depending on the information provided by the Analytical Services Bureau.
