This is a request to grant an ordinance for CCD to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the Regional Transportation District (RTD), whereby RTD and the City are willing to transfer certain land located within the area of the RTD West Corridor to the other party to further the Project, and the mutually agreed-to appraised value of property transferred by the City to RTD shall be credited to the City’s local match obligation.

6. General description of proposed ordinance including contract scope of work if applicable:

This ordinance will allow CCD to sign an IGA with RTD so that:

1. RTD agrees to convey, transfer, grant, sell and deliver to the City whatever interest RTD holds in the portions of RTD Land required for dedication as public right of way as part of the West Corridor FasTracks project.
2. The City agrees to transfer and sell to RTD and RTD agrees to accept and receive from the City and shall credit to the City whatever title the City holds in the City Land that is required for construction of the West Corridor FasTracks project, except that the City may retain of certain easement rights through a part or the whole of the City Land.
3. The Parties shall work with CDOT in order to complete CDOT’s purchase from the City of the Park Land required for the widening of Federal Boulevard at 13th Avenue on or before August 1, 2010.
4. RTD shall grant a temporary easement in the Temporary Bike Path to the City by means of a easement. The temporary easement will allow a detour of the existing bike path to be constructed and maintained by the City, at the City’s sole expense. The temporary

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easement shall run through December 31, 2015 or until such time as the existing pedestrian bike path on the west side of the Platte River is restored, whichever is earlier.
