A BILL

For an ordinance approving and providing for the execution of a proposed grant agreement between the City and County of Denver and the State of Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment concerning the "Gulch Park Improvements – Westerly Creek" project and the funding therefor.

WHEREAS, the City and County of Denver has given due consideration to said proposed Grant Agreement;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DENVER:

Section 1. The proposed Grant Agreement between the State of Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment and the City and County of Denver, a copy of which is duly filed with the City Clerk, Filing No. 2014-0557, be and hereby is approved in all respects.

Section 2. The payments made by the State of Colorado to the City pursuant to and under the Grant Agreement shall be deposited into the Treasury of the City and credited to Special Fund No. 38000, which is set forth and described in Section 20-18 of the Revised Municipal Code of the City and County of Denver.

Section 3. Expenditures are hereby authorized from the Grant/Other Capital Projects Fund, Accounting No. 38000, in the amounts of money in the following tabulation to be expended for the purposes and upon the authorizations in said Ordinance set forth:

The foregoing authorization will restore Westerly Creek channel bank from erosion between 13th St. and Xenia and expenditures will cover the period from July 1, 2014 to December 31, 2015. The City will provide a match for this project of up to \$250,000 of CIP funds.

2 and directed to make such book and record entries and to do such other things as may be
3 necessary to accomplish the purposes of this Ordinance.
